The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

It is contended that no legal proceedings have been initiated against the private respondents, despite the representation dated 11.09.2018. Learned counsel for the petitioners urges that the representation should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Mr. P.P. Chahar, DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioners within a period of eight weeks, on receipt

of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 11.09.2018 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioners within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law. The official respondents will also consider the threat perceptions of the petitioners and would provide necessary protection to them, if so required.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
