1. In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner with further prayer to direct respondents No. 2 and 3 to decide representations of the petitioner dated 20.08.2018 and 27.08.2018, Annexures P-1 and P-2 respectively in accordance with law.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose of the instant petition would be achieved, if respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, is directed to decide representation dated 27.08.2018 (Annexure P-2), moved by the petitioner.

3. In view of the above, respondent No. 2-Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, is directed to look into the matter and decide representation Annexure P-2, moved by the petitioner, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of

hearing to him, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
