The petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.170 dated 28.5.2018 registered at Police Station City Khanna, District Ludhiana, under Section 22 and 25 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'the NDPS Act').

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not an accused in any other case under the NDPS Act. The F.S.L. report has not been received till date. Thus, he be granted interim bail till the date of receipt of the F.S.L. report.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforementioned factual submissions.

I, therefore, deem it appropriate to grant interim bail to the petitioner till the date of receipt of F.S.L. report.

Kumar be released on interim bail till the date of receipt of report of the F.S.L., subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Judge, Special Court concerned. The petitioner shall surrender before the trial Court/Judge, Special Court concerned on the date when report of the F.S.L. is received.
