Vide order dated 03.11.2017, warrants of arrest of the petitioners were stayed by this Court and accordingly they appeared before the trial Court on 06.11.2017.

Counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have joined the proceedings of the trial and, therefore, they have complied with the orders of this Court and the purpose for which they were summoned stands achieved.

The contention of learned counsel for the petitioners primarily appears to be correct. However, let an application for grant of regular bail be moved before the trial Court, which shall be considered and decided by

passing an appropriate order in accordance with law. In case the petitioners move an application for grant of regular bail on or before 20.01.2018, the date already fixed before the trial Court, the same shall be considered and decided at an early date.

Till the decision on the application for grant of regular bail to the petitioners, interim order dated 03.11.2017 shall remain operative.

The petition accordingly stands disposed of.
