In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.0079 dated 08.08.2018 under Sections 420/471/379/411/120-B IPC (Annexure P-1) further added Section 3(1) (2) of the Prevention of Tampering of the Mobile device Equipment Identification Act, 2017, registered at Police Station City I, Mansa, District Mansa.

2.) Allegation against the petitioner is that he was selling stolen mobiles to co-accused. Allegation against the co-accused were relating to tampering the IMEI number with certain software. Thus, it is evident that petitioner is involved in either selling mobiles or he is in possession of stolen mobiles, consequently, selling those mobiles to different parties. For

the purpose of interrogation, petitioner's arrest is necessary to elicit how the

stolen mobiles are being transacted between the various parties. etc. Thus. Petitioner has not made out a case for seeking anticipatory bail.

3.) Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
