In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.13 dated 3.2.2015 registered under Section 21 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act 1985 at Police Station Fatehgarh Panj Toor District Moga.
