The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 133 dated 20.05.2018, under Sections 380, 454 and 411 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Ludhiana.

The operative part of the order dated 21.09.2018, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and his name has been surfaced after the arrest of two persons, namely, Jatinder Kumar @ Raju and Kuldeep Singh who have already been granted concession of regular bail.

Notice of motion for 04.12.2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 21.09.2018, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurpreet Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the

petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 21.09.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
