INDERJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.10 dated 08.01.2016, registered at Police Station Sector-34, Chandigarh, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 307 and 506 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Section 302 of IPC was added later on).

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned A.P.P for U.T.Chandigarh has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned A.P.P for U.T. Chandigarh and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that in the present case, occurrence took place on 08.01.2016 and victim-Pardeep Khatkar died on

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17.06.2016 and then, offence under Section 302 of IPC was added. Though the present petitioner has been named in the FIR, yet no specific injury has been attributed to him.

The petitioner has been in custody since 17.11.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
