The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.163, dated 13.11.2016 registered under Sections 447, 511, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka (Annexure P-1) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to the order dated 01.11.2017, report dated 20.11.2017 has been received from Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Fazilka. According to this report, statements of the parties have been recorded and that the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between the parties voluntarily, without any threat or coercion.
