1. In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for direction to respondents No. 1 and 2 to register FIR against respondent No. 3 and 4 under Sections 323, 452, 497, 506, 120-B IPC and directing them for conducting fair and proper investigation.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose of the instant petition would be achieved, at this stage, if a direction is issued to decide the representation (Annexure P-2), submitted to the DGP, Punjab, and take legal action thereon in accordance with law.
3. In view of the above, respondent No. 2- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana is directed to decide the representation (Annexure P-2), if any, of the petitioner allegedly filed before him or to get the same decided from his subordinate officer not below the rank of Deputy Commissioner of Police under his supervision, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to him, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
4. The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
