RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

Petitioners have sought issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 in the context of protection of their lives and personal liberties.

Both the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. Settlement has already been fructified. Following terms and conditions were agreed before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court:-

“(a). That Balwinder Kaur-mother and Gurnam Singh-father of petitioner No.1 has made a separate statement which is

reduced into writing duly signed by the respondent No.4 and 5, advocates of the respondent No.4 and 5 (mother and father of the petitioner No.1) and the undersigned mediator. Copy of the statement given by respondent No.4 and 5 is annexed as Annexure 'A' which is enclosed with the present settlement.

(b) that now there is no dispute left between the parties as the father and mother of the petitioner No.1 has blessed the petitioners and they have further stated that they assured the daughter and son-in-law that no harm/interference will be done by them or by their relatives in their matrimonial life in future.

(c) That petitioners are happy and satisfied by the assurance given by the respondent No.4 and 5 (mother and father of the petitioner No.1).”

With the aforesaid settlement, dispute between the parties has been settled. Both the parties undertook that they will be bound by the terms and conditions of the settlement and the violation thereof, would entail in taking recourse to law by the parties.

In view of settlement, this petition is disposed of by giving liberties to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies available to them. Petitioners may report to

respondent No.3 along with copy of this order. In case of any contingency, respondent No.3 will be at liberty to take all remedial steps to ensure that no harm is caused in this context to the petitioners, if they are not involved in any other case.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
