CRM-M No.28991 of 2017 has also been decided qua
petitioner No.3 vide order of even date.

In the instant case, on 02.02.2018, following order was
passed:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends
that petitioners are accused in cross version to FIR
No.40 dated 22.05.2016 registered under sections 307,
323, 427, 148, 149, 120-B IPC and Sections 25, 27 of
the Arms Act. Learned counsel submits that petitioners'
side received as many as 56 injuries in the incident in
which accused in the FIR tried to dispossess the
petitioner from the land of which possession was*

delivered under the orders of the High Court. In CRM-M No.28332 of 2016, Inspector General of Police, Patiala Range was asked to look into the matter and file detailed reply vide order dated 16.08.2016. A reply was filed by Inspector General of Police, in which it was disclosed that Harjinder Singh @ Gaggi of opposite party duly armed in planned manner along with Sarpanch and Nihang Singhs attacked on Bhupinder Singh to take possession of the land. Thereafter, while disposing of a bunch of petition, this Court in CRM-M No.28797 of 2016 granted anticipatory bail to the accused in the FIR on the ground that neither of the injured of both the sides suffered any gun shot injury. CRM-M No.28991 of 2017 filed by co-accused Rohi Singh and others is fixed for 09.02.2018 before this Court. Notice of motion for 09.02.2018.

In the meanwhile, petitioners are directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 05.02.2018 and in the event of their arrest, they shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioners shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M No.28991 of 2017.”

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Harminder Singh submits that in compliance of aforesaid order, petitioners have joined the investigation and recovery has been effected from petitioner No.1. They are no more required for

further investigation in the case.

In view of above, order dated 02.02.2018 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
