The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure (in short, “Cr.P.C”) for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.31 dated 27.6.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 489-A, 489-B, 489-C of Indian Penal Code (for short, “IPC”) at Police Station Division No.1, Pathankot.

Heard.

Although the petitioner is not named in the FIR, rather he has been dragged in the present case on the basis of the disclosure statement of the co-accused, yet 17 fake currency notes i.e. 4 fake currency notes in the denomination of ₹ 2,000/- and 13 fake currency notes in the denomination of ₹ 500/- along with one printer and one dye having impression of Mahatma Gandhi along with relevant material were recovered.

The petitioner was arrested on 27.6.2018. Challan has already

been submitted.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Sunny son of Sukhdev Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
