ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.(ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 69 dated 06.06.2018, registered under Sections 384, 506, 420, 120-B, 376 IPC, Sections 7, 13(2) of the PC Act and Sections 3 & 4 of the SC ST Act Police Station City Raikot, District Ludhiana.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 06.06.2018 and challan has been presented. Counsel further submits that the petitioner in fact is the victim of extortion and Kulwinder Kaur arranged a married woman and a police official was called to prepare a video and thereafter they confronted the petitioner with that video and extorted money and the police registered the FIR on the basis of a secret information and they were caught on the spot and the victim now alleges rape and she is a married woman.

Challan has already been presented. The trial would take time to conclude. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
