Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.54 dated 22.05.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 325, 341, 307, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Nawanshahr, District SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that on the basis of statement made by Tara Singh-complainant in the case, no injury has been attributed to the petitioner. He is in custody since 26.06.2018 and trial in this case will take a long time.

Learned State Counsel has filed the custody certificate of the petitioner in court today, which is taken on record.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh states that complainant-Tara Singh as well as Surinder Singh, Mangat Rai and Rajnish Kumar were injured in the case. However, when a specific

query is put as to whether any injury has been attributed to the petitioner which may invoke Sections 324, 325, 307 IPC, learned State Counsel has argued that in this case victim Surinder Singh has got injury on the head, whereas victim Mangat Rai has been inflicted injury on the right hand and leg and Rajnish Kumar on his forehead, but all these injuries are simple under Sections 324, 325 IPC.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 26.06.2018 and trial in this case may take a long time, therefore, I deem it appropriate to admit the petitioner on regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
