The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 17, dated 17.1.2018, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Ferozepur, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 25.9.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get the statements recorded.

Report of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ferozepur has been received to the effect that statement of complainant Saraj Singh and also of petitioners/accused Bohar Singh, Jaswant Singh, Sarwan

Singh and Chanan Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have entered into a compromise with the intervention of respectables. The complainant has specifically stated that he has no objection if the FIR in the present case is quashed. The learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ferozepur opined that the compromise entered into between the parties is genuine, voluntary and without any inducement, threat, pressure or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid report and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 17, dated 17.1.2018, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Ferozepur, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
