Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.60 dated 04.08.2017, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

It is a case where the present petitioner who was himself a complainant in the matter has been nominated as an accused.

As per statement of the petitioner on the basis of which the FIR was registered, certain parcel of land under the ownership of Amar Kaur daughter of Harnam Singh had been sold to one Swaran Singh by Mohinder Kaur, Tarsem Singh Nambardar and Charan Singh by conniving with each other.

Petitioner in his complaint had asserted that Amar Kaur had in fact executed a Will on 08.09.2010 bequeathing the same very land in favour of the petitioner as also his two other brothers, namely, Balbir Singh and Puran Singh.

During the Course of investigation, it apparently has transpired that it is mother of the petitioner, namely, Mohinder Kaur who has impersonated for the real owner i.e. Amar Kaur to facilitate the transaction. It is under such circumstances that the present petitioner has been roped in having acted as an alleged conspirator.

Petitioner was arrested on 02.09.2017.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan was presented on 30.11.2017. All the documentary evidence is already in the possession of the investigating agency.

The trial is at the very initial stage and would take time to conclude.

Without making any observations on merit, the present petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Kapurthala.
