Prayer in this petition is for setting aside the order dated 02.04.2016, passed by Judicial Magistrate First Class, Nakodar, vide which, the petitioners were summoned under Section 190 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'Cr.P.C.).

This petition is pending since 2016 and there is no stay of proceedings.

Learned State counsel submits that in the intervening period, out of the 11 prosecution witnesses, the trial Court has recorded the statement of 06 witnesses and the petitioners are facing the trial.

In view of the same, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be permitted to raise all the defence pleas before the trial Court during the course of trial.
