Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.353 dated 14.09.2017 under Section 302, 201, 34 IPC and Section 25 Arms Act registered at Police Station Ladwa, Kurukshetra.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gorinder Singh submits that trial in the present case is at an advance stage, as out of the total 21 witnesses, as cited by the prosecution, as many as 12 witnesses have already been examined, 4 witnesses have been given up and only 5 witnesses are required to be examined and the case is now fixed for 06.10.2018 for examination of the remaining witnesses.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of this petition.
