Petitioners apprehend threat to their lives and liberty from respondents No. 4 to 6 and have, therefore, highlighted this position in their representation dated 29.01.2018 (Annexure P-7) addressed to the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar and S.H.O. Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar, respondents No. 2 and 3 respectively.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar and S.H.O. Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar, respondents No. 2 and 3 respectively to look into the representation dated 29.01.2018 (Annexure P-7) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners and without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar and S.H.O. Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar, respondents No. 2 and 3 respectively to look into the representation dated 29.01.2018 (Annexure P-7) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law, if required.
