Consequently, without making any comment whatsoever, in any manner, with regard to the grievance of the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Director General of Police, Haryana (respondent no. 2 herein), to go in the representations (if made) and to take a decision as per law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

In any case, the petitioner would be at liberty to approach the DGP again for his grievance and a decision would be taken as per law by the DGP within three months, thereafter, as to whether there is any 'genuineness' in the petitioners' contentions.
