The grievance of the petitioners is that on account of inter caste marriage between the son of petitioner Nos.1 and 2 and the daughter of respondent No.6, they are facing threats from respondent No.6 as he is a police official and thus, they fear for their lives and liberty as well as of false implication in criminal cases. A representation dated 05.09.2018 (Annexure P3) has been submitted, but no action has been taken thereupon, till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. S.P. Singh, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5. Let six copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent No.6, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P3) and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, in case it is found necessary, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, it shall be ensured that lives and liberty of the petitioners be protected.
