The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in cross-case vide Rapat/DDR No.54 dated 25.07.2018, under Sections 324, 326, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code in case FIR No.135 dated 22.07.2018, under Sections 452, 354, 148, 149 of Indian penal Code, registered at Police Station Ajnala, Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, have joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from them.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they

are not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation and have joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 25.09.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
