The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.41 dated 22.1.2018, registered at Police Station City Narnaul, District Mohindergarh, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325, 506, 302, 34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an old lady, aged about 58 years. She has been in custody since 22.1.2018. The investigation is now complete, but the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as no PW has been examined till date. Moreover, the petitioner is attributed a simple injury to the complainant and a simple injury to the deceased person. Thus, the petitioner deserves to be released on regular bail.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the factual submissions.

It is thus, clear that the petitioner is not attributed the fatal blow on the head of the deceased person. She is an aged lady. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date and there is no criminal case pending against her.

Keeping in view the facts of this case, I deem it appropriate to allow this petition. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and

petitioner Ramkala, is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
