By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect his life and liberty as he apprehends threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.6 to 9.

Learned counsel has submitted that he plies an Auto Rickshaw and that on 04.07.2018 his vehicle was stopped and he was inflicted injuries including grievous injuries and his mobile phone as well as his money that he was carrying was snatched and although he had made a representation to the police but no action has been taken thereupon.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police, Nuh (Mewat) to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-3) expeditiously and in case, the allegations made therein are found to be well-founded then necessary steps warranted under law be taken thereupon at the earliest. It is further directed that in case, there is any genuine apprehension of threat to life and liberty of the petitioner, then adequate steps be taken so as to ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioner or to other members of his family/witnesses.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-3) be sent to respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police, Nuh (Mewat) so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
