The present petition has been filed seeking protection of life and liberty as the petitioners fear that respondents No. 4 and 5 (father and mother of petitioner No. 2) will cause them bodily harm as their marriage has been performed against her wishes.

Petitioner No. 1 has submitted an affidavit stating that he is major and that no proof regarding his date of birth is available with him. Petitioner No. 2 is major and the same is proved by her Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2).

Be that as it may and without commenting upon the validity of the marriage between petitioners No. 1 and 2, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No. 2 to ensure that life and liberty of the petitioners is protected by providing them adequate protection after carrying out a threat assessment and as and when deemed appropriate. The representation (Annexure P-5) already made as well as the facts mentioned in this petition shall be kept in mind by him.

The petition is accordingly disposed of.
