The daughter of petitioners is stated to have married respondent No. 4. Petitioner No. 1 made complaint dated 10.8.2018 (Annexure-P-5) to Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur. Petitioners want impartial investigation into the matter.

I am of the view that unless FIR is registered against any person, no impartial inquiry can be ordered. Infact, petitioners want FIR to be registered against accused.

In these circumstances, petitioners are relegated to appear before the police and if police do not take any action thereon, seek appropriate remedy before the learned Illaqa Magistrate. Petitioners are always at liberty to move a fresh complaint before the police authorities.
