FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (Oral)

Report dated 30.10.2018 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, SAS Nagar (Mohali) has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Smt. Monika Thakur and accused Amrit Pal Singh Tiwana, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties voluntarily, out of their free will, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and the fact that the dispute, *inter-se*, between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offences for which the accused has been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another'** 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and

'Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another'

2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 84 dated 18.06.2017 registered at Police Station Mattaur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali under Sections 354 and 506 IPC and all consequences arising out therefrom qua the petitioners are hereby quashed.

The petition stands disposed off in those terms.
