MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present petition is filed praying for quashing FIR No.59,
dated 21.04.2016 under section 324,452,IPC (lateron offence u/s 326
IPC added), registered at Police Station Nangal, District Ropar, on
the basis of compromise entered in two between the parties.

2. Heard.

3. Both the parties were directed by this Court vide order dated 08-02-2017 to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate, Police Station Nangal, District Ropar to record their statements and in pursuance thereof, learned SDJM/ Sri Anandpur Sahib recorded the statement of both the parties and submitted a report dated 20.02.2017. A perusal of the report reveals that the compromise entered into between the parties is voluntary and without any fear, coercion, inducement or threat. Even before this Court also, none of the parties has any objection for quashing of the FIR in question.

4. Inasmuch as the dispute between the parties has been amicably settled and they have already entered into compromise, any their continuance of the prosecution would be an exercise in futility. Therefore, the aforesaid FIR and all consequent proceedings resulting therefrom are quashed.

5. Petition is allowed.
