1. In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for direction to respondents No. 3 and 4 in the case FIR No. 0048 dated 22.04.2018 under Sections 326, 324, 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC, 1860 and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar (Rural).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose of the instant petition would be achieved, at this stage, if a direction is issued to decide the representation (Annexure P-3) which is pending before respondent No. 3 and also to take appropriate legal action on it expeditiously.
3. In view of the above, respondent No. 3- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Jalandhar (Rural), is directed to look into the matter and decide the representation (Annexure P-3) moved by the petitioner, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to him, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
4. The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
