The grievance of the petitioner is that he is being harassed by respondent Nos.4 and 5 at the behest of respondent No.6 with whom a civil dispute is pending. The petitioner has agreed to sell certain land to respondent No.6, but the said respondent could not make the payment on the due date and thus, the amount of earnest money was forfeited in terms of the agreement to sell. Respondent No.6 has now preferred a suit for specific performance and the same is pending. Meanwhile, the petitioner is being harassed and threatened by respondent No.6 through respondent Nos.4 and 5. A representation dated 10.09.2018 (Annexure P2) has been submitted, but no action has been taken thereupon, till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. K.S. Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.4 to 6, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to objectively consider the representation 10.09.2018 (Annexure P2) and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, in case it is found necessary, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
