On 03.11.2017, following order was passed by the co-  
Ordinate Bench of this Court:-

*"Heard.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that anticipatory bail was declined to the petitioner on the ground that he is also involved in case bearing FIR No.241 dated 01.09.2017 registered at Police Station Chandi Mandir for offence punishable under Sections 457 and 380 IPC. In that case, petitioner was allowed interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 06.10.2017 passed in CRM-M-36715-2017. In other case registered against the petitioner bearing FIR No.173 dated 17.06.2017 for offences punishable under Sections 457 and 511 IPC, he was allowed anticipatory bail by the lower Court.*

*Notice of motion for 18.01.2018.*

*In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within two weeks. In the event of his arrest being required, he shall be released on interim bail till the next date, subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, he shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which he shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to him.”*

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Jagdish Kumar submitted that though the petitioner has joined the investigation but recovery of Rs.2950/- is still to be effected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner undertakes to join investigation forthwith and would facilitate the recovery of the aforesaid amount.

Subject to complying with the aforesaid direction, the interim order dated 03.11.2017 is made absolute, however it is made clear that if the petitioner does not facilitate the recovery of Rs.2950/- within one week, then the present petition shall be deemed to be dismissed without making any further reference to the Court.
