GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.878 dated 05.08.2018 Police Station Sadar Karnal, District Karnal under Sections 323, 436, 452, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 26.09.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements

recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the petitioner as well as of complainant-Baljeet Kaur have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter. It has specifically been opined by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal that the compromise is genuine and has been effected voluntarily without there being any undue influence or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.878 dated 05.08.2018 Police Station Sadar Karnal, under Sections 323, 436, 452, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
