Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 10.

Though in the petition, it is alleged that the petitioners have performed marriage, however, considering the limited scope of this petition regarding protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court as respondents No.4 to 10 have appeared through their counsel.

The Mediator has recorded the statements of both the petitioners.

Petitioner No.1 – Kulvinder Kaur has stated that she was engaged with one Jagdeep Singh two years ago and on 23.09.2018 due to some misunderstanding with her parents, she left her parental home in a state of anger and ran away with petitioner No.2 of her own

consent and he has not compelled/coerce her to take any such step. It is further stated that she has met her family members as well as the aforesaid Jagdeep Singh and has realized that her decision to go with petitioner No.2 is not a correct decision and she want to go with her parents.

In the statement of petitioner No.2 – Lakhvir Singh, it is stated that he had run away with petitioner No.1 of her own wish and thereafter, they have filed the present petition.

In view of the statement of petitioner No.1 that she has taken a wrong decision to go with petitioner No.2 and does not want to live with him rather wants to go with her fiancé i.e. Jagdeep Singh, without commenting anything about the marital status of both the petitioners and in view of the fact that both of them are major and are capable of taking their independent decision and they have got their statements recorded before the Mediator of their own free will and without any pressure, no further action is required.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of.

The parties will remain bound by their own statements.
