ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.53 dated 16.02.2017, registered under Section 376 D, 312 and 149 IPC and offences under Sections 380 and 411 IPC added later on, at Police Station City Sangrur, Tehsil & District Sangrur.

I have heard both the sides.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the complainant had levelled allegations under Section 376 IPC and she made a supplementary complaint against him that the gold ornaments had been handed over to the petitioner and the allegations are only under Sections 380 and 411 IPC. Counsel further submits that the petitioner is in custody since August, 2017 and the statement of the complainant has been recorded in the Court.

The allegations against the petitioner are only under Sections 380 and 411 IPC.

The trial would take time. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate.
