By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.89 dated 13.7.2018 registered under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Verowal, District Tarn Taran and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 26.9.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Khadur Sahib has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of petitioner Rajwant Kaur and also of complainant Nirmaljeet Kaur have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter and that they have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Khadur Sahib

that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.89 dated 13.7.2018 registered under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Verowal, District Tarn Taran and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
