In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for regular bail under the provision of Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.0336 dated 20.08.2017 registered under Sections 395, 397, 412 & 379-B IPC at Police Station Sadar, Sonipat District Sonipat.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that co-accused namely Deepak has been granted the benefit of bail on 9.10.2018. It was also contended that complainant has been examined and trial of the case would take some more time to conclude. Therefore, petitioner is entitled to regular bail.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sunil Kumar has not disputed the aforesaid position.

4 Accordingly, petitioner is entitled to bail. Hence, without commenting any opinion on the merit of case, petitioner-Naresh @ Nishu is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail/surety bonds to the entire satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

6. Petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and he shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

7. Petition is allowed accordingly.
