The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.0239 dated 15th April, 2017, registered under Sections 323, 307, 452, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

The petitioner was arrested on 15th April, 2017.

It transpires from the Compromise Deed and affidavit of the complainant (Annexures P-1 and P-2) that the dispute has been amicably resolved between the parties. This is a major mitigating

circumstance, irrespective of the ultimate result after completion of trial.

The present petitioner namely Karan Singh @ Ranu, may therefore be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
