This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.103, dated 27.09.2013, under Sections 21/22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar.

On 06.11.2017, the following order was passed by this Court:

“In the light of the contentions raised by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had been regularly appearing before the learned trial Court and only on single date i.e. 13.10.2017 he could not appear due to the circumstances beyond his control, notice of motion for 13.03.2018.

In the meantime, the petitioner shall put in appearance before the concerned Court within a period of ten days of this order and upon doing so, he shall be released on bail. However, this order shall become automatically inoperative, if there is a default on the part of the petitioner in putting appearance on more than one occasion.”

During the course of arguments today, it has gone uncontroverted that the petitioner has since appeared before the trial Court

and has joined trial proceedings.

In view of the above, prayer made in the instant petition is accepted.

Petition is allowed. Order dated 06.11.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute.
