1. In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 to take action in accordance with law against respondents No. 4 to 7 on the complaint dated 14.08.2018.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the purpose of the instant petition would be achieved, at this stage, if a direction is issued to decide the representation (Annexure P-7) which is pending before respondent No. 2 and also to take appropriate legal action on it expeditiously.

3. In view of the above, respondent No. 2- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, is directed to look into the matter and to decide the representation (Annexure P-7) moved by the petitioner, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to him, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
