The instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to take legal action against the accused in case FIR No. 134 dated 02.05.2016 under Sections 363 and 366A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Nissing. In this regard the petitioner has also approached the authorities by filing representation dated 30.06.2017 (Annexure P-3) but till date no action has been taken by respondent No.2 on the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if respondent No.2 be directed to look into the representation dated 30.06.2017 (Annexure P-3) and take action in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr.P.P. Chahar, learned DAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Three copies of the petition be handed over to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during the course of the day failing which no action is called for. He submits that representation dated 30.06.2017 (Annexure P-3) will be decided within a period of four weeks.

Without going into the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide representation dated 30.06.2017 (Annexure P-3), within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order and take necessary action in accordance with law.
