Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to petitioner Sanjay in a case arising from FIR No.166 dated 23.05.2018 registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that FSL report has not yet been received. Therefore, it cannot be said at this stage that 110 injections allegedly recovered from the petitioner contained any narcotic substance. Petitioner is in custody since 25.05.2018.

Learned State counsel has filed Custody Certificate of the petitioner in Court, which is taken on record.

In view of above, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petitioner is granted interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and two sureties of ₹2.00 lakh each, to the satisfaction of Special Court concerned only till receipt of the FSL report.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
