There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner even on 4th call, and at the end of the day.

The prayer made in this case is for direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to register the FIR under Sections 323, 324, 341, 352, 426, 427, 445, 500 & 506 read with Section 120-B & 34-IPC, against respondents No.4 & 10 and their associates. Further prayer is that the proceedings initiated against the petitioner under Section 107/150 of Cr.P.C. be also stayed.

Perusal of the file shows that the dispute in this case is predominantly related to the civil rights of the parties. Therefore, it is not a fit case for issuing any direction for registering FIR against respondents, as claimed in the petition.

Still further, the prayer for quashing of the proceedings under Section 107/150 Cr.P.C. also cannot be entertained because the authorities have undertaken the proceedings under the statutory provisions in view of

the facts and circumstances of the case.

No specific ground is made out in the petition to stay the proceedings undertaken by the statutory authorities.

Hence, the petition is dismissed.
