This petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeks release of petitioner on regular bail in FIR No.124 dated 11.05.2017 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at police station DIV No.5, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

2. The petitioner has undergone detention for almost seven months by now.

3. Investigation has already been completed and charges have been framed.

4 Further indefinite detention of the petitioner, in the circumstances, is not justified.

In view of above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely Deepak Arora son of Khalanda, is directed to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, with a direction to report at the concerned police station once a week during the pendency of the trial.
