Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing of FIR No.264 dated 07.12.2017 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 427, 447 and 506 of IPC registered at Police Station Ghall Khurd, District Ferozepur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of affidavit in the shape of compromise arrived at between them.

Vide order dated 27.09.2018, parties were directed to appear before the Trial Court for recording their statement qua compromise between them and the trial court was directed to report as to whether compromise between them is genuine without any pressure or undue influence and also whether any accused was declared as proclaimed offender. Vide letter No.876 dated 12.10.2018, Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ferozepur duly forwarded by District and Sessions Judge, Ferozepur vide letter No.11800/EB dated 12.10.2018

has reported that compromise between the petitioners and complainant is genuine, without any pressure or undue influence and in favour of the parties to live with peace and harmony.

Considering the above report and compromise between the parties and the fact that compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, aforesaid FIR No.264 dated 07.12.2017 and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, is quashed qua petitioners, subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- out of which Rs.4000/- shall be deposited with the Bar Association of Punjab and Haryana High Court, Rs.1000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana and Rs.5000/- with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Legal Services Committee within one week from today, failing which the petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.

Disposed of accordingly.
