This petition has been filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal procedure for quashing the FIR No.110 dated 18.03.2014 under Section 406, 498-A of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Sector 39, Chandigarh and the proceedings pending therein.

Learned counsel for the respondent No.2 submits the evidence in the said case is completed and the matter is now listed for final arguments.

No one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

A perusal of the *zimini* orders would reveal that there was no stay of the proceedings pending before the trial Court. In fact, notice of motion was issued primarily on the premise that the matter should be referred to Mediation & Conciliation Centre for a compromise.

Since this petition is pending in this Court since the year 2014 and charges had been framed as far back in May, 2017 and now the matter is posted for final arguments, no further orders are called for in this instant petition which stands disposed of.
