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**SURINDER GUPTA, J.(Oral)**

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.32 dated 23.04.2018 registered for offences punishable under Sections 323 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") and 3 of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, at Police Station City-2, Mansa, District Mansa.

Heard.

As per case of prosecution, the occurrence took place on 20.04.2018, when complainant-Manpreet Singh was allegedly given beating and attributed casteist words. Injuries on the person of complainant were found simple in nature caused by blunt weapon. Petitioner was arrested in this case on 10.08.2018 and after completion of investigation challan against him has been presented by the police in Court.

In view of above but without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take

considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Naib Singh is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
