Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.0076 dated 31.03.2017 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station, Division No.2, Ludhiana and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 10.07.2017 (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to the order dated 24.05.2018 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 01.06.2018 to get their statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.330, dated 13.07.2018 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, vide letter No.588, dated 13.07.2018. According to the report, learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, is satisfied that compromise entered into

between the parties is genuine, voluntary and without any inducement or

pressure. No proceeding is pending against the accused. Considering the report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, dated 13.07.2018 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, aforesaid FIR No.0076 dated 31.03.2017 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station, Division No.2, Ludhiana and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, is quashed, subject to payment of costs of Rs. 10,000/-, out of which Rs. 4,000/- shall be deposited with the Bar Association of Punjab and Haryana High Court, Rs. 1,000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana and Rs. 5,000/- with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Legal Services Committee within one week from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.

Disposed of accordingly.

Adjourned to 30.10.2018 for production of receipts.
