Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondents no.1 to 4 not to harass the petitioner by calling her time and again without following the procedure under Section 160 Cr.P.C.

A detailed reply has been filed by the Assistant Inspector General of Police, NRI Wing, Patiala, dated 06.12.2018, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 is on record, in which it is explained that on account of a matrimonial dispute between Rupinder Kaur and Tejinderpal Singh, the police was conducting the inquiry and as per the directions of the Honb'le Supreme Court in Criminal Appeal No.1265 of 2017, titled as "Rajesh Sharma and others vs. State of Uttar Pradesh and others, dated 27.07.2017, the complaint was referred to Family Welfare Committee-2, Sangrur and the same was later on disposed of on 01.11.2017.

In view of the same, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petition be disposed of as infructuous, at this stage.
