The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Sunita @ Mahi in case FIR No.252 dated 10.08.2018 registered for the offence punishable under Section 22 of Narcotics Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (in short, "NDPS") at Police Station Dakha, Ludhiana Rural, District Ludhiana.

Heard.

Learned State counsel submits that Forensic Science Laboratory report has not been received.

Learned counsel for petitioner has placed reliance on the judgment of this Court in *Inderjeet Singh @ Laddi and others v. State of Punjab; 2014 (3) RCR (Criminal) 953*.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the circumstances of this case, the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial

Magistrate/Duty Magistrate till the submission of the FSL report. In case it is found that the contraband falls under the commercial quantity, the petitioner shall surrender before the learned trial court and seek regular bail in the case.
